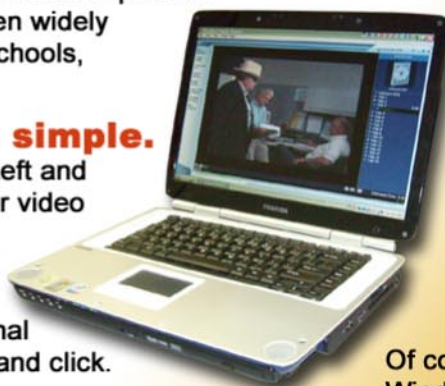


## DVD is an excellent medium for training.
